Child A

ACTIONS ONLY

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Child A's tragic death occurred in circumstances where a local multi-agency review was considered to be of benefit by the Safeguarding Partnership. This review has largely concluded but publishing it at this stage would prejudice the ongoing criminal investigation. Therefore, the action plan is published to enhance accountability and ensure transparency. Work to embed the learning from the review has already begun.

Action 1

The details and description of how any injury occurred, should be on all children's Emergency Department (ED) discharge summary reports for information sharing with GP and the 0-19 service. Bassetlaw ED to review and ensure mandatory reporting of mechanism of injury on all children that attend with injury.

Action 2

The Local Authority and CAFCASS should provide detail to the Practice, Performance and Learning Delivery Group of their respective assessment processes and assurance that all relevant children are considered, and that staff are supported in relation to professional curiosity and analysis.

Action 3

RSCP to develop an updated training programme within the RSCP Neglect Delivery Group, reporting into the Practice Performance and Learning Delivery Group, which responds to the circumstances for Child A and the learning.

Action 4

Development of an educational neglect and safeguarding pathway for vulnerable children in education, including those that are Electively Home Educated. Progress on this action should be overseen by the RSCP Safeguarding in Education Delivery Group, with assurance provided to the Practice, Performance and Learning Delivery Group.

Action 5

The Safeguarding in Education Delivery Group will oversee and monitor multi agency practice in this field, specifically ensuring that the findings and actions from this report are addressed, with assurance provided to the Practice, Performance and Learning Delivery Group and into the Executive. These factors are already contained in the terms of reference for the group and should be reviewed and enhanced if necessary.

Action 6

TRFT to provide assurance as to the detail and content of notifications into the Elective Home Education service to ensure all notifications provide as detailed information as possible.
